psychological intellectual and socioemotional differences with personal and environmental factors including attitudes cultural beliefs legal and economic policies transportation buildings etc disability is also part of being human disability affects more than one billion people worldwide 1 2 according to the united nations convention on the rights of persons with disabilities people with disabilities include those who have long term physical mental intellectual or sensory such as hearing or vision impairments

which in interaction with various barriers may hinder their full and effective americans with disabilities act ada the ada prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in employment state and local government public accommodations commercial facilities transportation and telecommunications it also applies to the united states congress to be protected by the ada one must have a disability or have a relationship or association with an relationshipbuilders-lakeland.com
